The congregation of the Unitarian Church of Edmonton has just made a bold new commitment to children and youth, by funding an expansion of its Child and Youth Religious Exploration program. Now it needs the right person to lead that program.

The congregation has given a major increase to the salary of the Child and Youth Religious Exploration Leader (RE Leader). It has also provided money to hire a third part-time worker to help with the program on Sundays.

Our current RE Leader, Lauren Kay, is leaving town so the Unitarian Church of Edmonton needs a new leader for its children and youth programs.

It's a great job for the right person.

The Job:

- Provide a program of religious education for children aged 5 to 11 years; oversee our nursery and youth programs.
- Work with volunteers and with paid assistants who help with the program.

Benefits:

- Pay of \$20 an hour for up to 30 hours a week, 43 weeks a year. Total pay: \$25,800 a year.
- A work year that starts in late August and ends in late June.
- Up to 60 paid hours of extra time for training and preparation. We will provide a trainer.
- An RSP retirement benefit plan, worth \$1,240, which will increase each year.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience teaching children.
- Skills in organization, leadership and supervision.
- Good spoken and written English; good online research and communication skills.
- Willingness to learn about Unitarian Universalist principles of love, justice and spiritual growth.
