Major Actions of 2018-19

- General building maintenance, planned and as needed
 - Plumbing and heating issues in tenant spaces and the UCE space
- General refresh of building, repainting of hallway walls, bathrooms and Keeler Hall
 - Mohammed Adam spent many hours in repainting our space
- Reduced our Carbon Footprint
 - Almost half of the lights in UCE/Tenant spaces have been changed to LED courtesy of the Government program
- Found and hired new Janitors
- Repainted parking lots lines
- Replaced phone system with IP phones saving UCE over \$200 per month
- Maintenance tools and equipment are more organized
- Moved items around the building as requested
- Regular Pest patrol duties
- Fix and repainted the benches in the garden
- Fixed and repainted the picnic table

Outcomes Achieved

Planned Actions for 2019-20

- Replacement of the roof hatch
- Glass railing in the youth loft

- Purchase and install and AED in the building
- Build a recycling center
- More cupboards in kitchen
- Replace our programmable thermostats with high efficiency thermostats

- Replace the rest of the lights in Tenant spaces with LED lights
- Replace the Rest of the lights in UCE with Led bulbs
- Replacing the pigeon netting at the front of the building
- Finish Drywall in stair case as per Fire Marshal

Recommendations for Board Consideration (if any)

- The siding outside the Main doors is falling apart and can no longer be fixed. We need to develop a plan for replacement
- The windows around the Learning Centre Tenant space are degrading fast, a couple of frames are rotten. We will need to look at replacing these within the next little while

Other Notes

- We try to reuse what we can where we can, but when we have to purchase items we look at the RESTORE and Architectural Clearing House before buying brand new.
- The volunteers spend a lot of time outside the church organizing and running around to find items needed
- 4 very committed volunteers show up every week they are in town and spent at least 5
 hours doing whatever needs to be done, in some cases helping out with things that fall
 outside their planned duties. These Gentlemen spent approximately 1000 hours last
 year in the building
