NEW BUSINESS

Allen Fund

Susan Ruttan advised that the Term Deposit which holds the Allen Fund, a youth fund, matures on Oct 28, 2016. The amount is currently \$5,166. **Moved** by Susan Ruttan, **seconded** by Yvonne Mireau, that we reinvest \$2,000 in a new 2 year GlCand transfer the balance to the YRUU (Youth) budget, for use by Lauren Kay as needed. **CARRIED**

Rentals

David Rae advised that he has been approached by church members inquiring whether they can rent UCE tables and chairs for an event at another location. The black stacking chairs belong to Chorealis and are used by 4 different choirs, therefore we are not willing to have the chairs leave the premises. In the past members have occasionally borrowed equipment such as tables and made a donation to the church. It was decided to handle such requests on a case by case basis.

Brian Kiely and Mike Keast confirmed that Lauren Kay is still having problems with REMA Ministries in that they are not respectful of materials she has prepared and left in the classroom for Sunday morning. Janet has been working with this group but they don't seem to get the message and therefore we will give them one more chance only. **Moved** by Yvonne Mireau, **seconded** by Karen Mills, that Janet has the discretion to terminate REMA Ministries rental if necessary. **CARRIED**

It was agreed that when Janet requires direction pertaining to rentals, she Email Mike Keast only, and Mike will determine whether to forward to all Board members.

Membership

The Membership Committee by their Minutes dated Sep 18, 2016, requested that the Board consider the following:

- have locks installed on all kitchen cabinets

It was agreed that a Kitchen Committee is not necessary as it is Janet's job to order supplies and check the kitchen. The new locks will take care of a lot of problems.

Someone was heard to comment that unlamented signs in the kitchen are contrary to health regulations. Our kitchen is inspected regularly so if there is a problem we will be advised by the proper authorities.

Social Justice

Yvonne attended a recent meeting and provided a report. The Social Justice Committee will be leading services on Feb 12 and May 21, 2017. The Committee is considering whether to continue their focus on Poverty and Homelessness, or to add a new focus such as Aboriginal Reconciliation.

Religious Exploration

Karen Mills advised that a meeting of the RE Committee is scheduled for Oct 23, 2016. Some of the parents are quite keen.

With respect to an Adult RE Committee, Brian will put an announcement in the newsletter and announce in church. Yvonne Mireau is the contact person.

The Property Management team made some required changes including moving a sink and installing fire lights and emergency exit lights. POLICY ON PETS

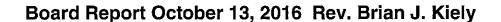
EFFECTIVE DATE: Oct 12, 2016

PURPOSE: the purpose of this policy is to help ensure the health and safety of congregational members, children and visitors by limiting the access that pets have to the building. This policy is necessary to create a safe place for all who come to UCE. This policy will protect individuals who potentially may have allergies, asthma or other medical issues that limit contact to animals as well as protecting individuals from potentially being bitten or otherwise injured by a pet.

POLICY: Pets and other animals are not allowed in the UCE building. The following exceptions are noted:

- 1. Service animals.
- 2. Special circumstances with the express permission of the Board of Trustees.
- 3. A program or service that is overseen and approved by the Church Services Committee.
