

On average the Unitarian Church of Edmonton Food Bank depot serves 40 families per week. That would be approximately 124 people per week.

In 2017 the total weight of the food issued from the Unitarian Church of Edmonton depot was 49,654 kg.

Each month, over 22,000 people receive food hampers from Edmonton's Food Bank. Approximately 40 % of clients served are children under 18.

The Edmonton Food Bank relies on your donations to continue their work. While the Food Bank receives some funding through the United Way, they do not receive any core government funding.
